CONFERENCE PAPERS FOR PUBLICATION

Rules and Guidelines:

- 1. Authors/Presenters are limited to two (2) abstracts as primary author or co-author. Each abstract may have a maximum of two (2) co-authors.
- 2. Deadline of full paper submission is on **December 31, 2019**.
- 3. The papers may be up to 7,000 words in length excluding index- bio (longer papers will be accepted 7,000 is a general guide line). Papers with over 10,000 words must be checked with us first.
- 4. Sample guidelines will be emailed to all those who attend.
- 5. A Publisher's session will be held at the conference by one of the editors and should be attended by the authors.
- 6. Before papers are sent to us, authors are required to do / take note of the following:
 - a. Do a spell and grammar check.
 - b. Do a plagiarism check and notify us of any false positives (many unique papers come up as 'plagiarized' on some of the checks even though they are clearly not).
 - c. Do NOT refer to Academia.edu papers as a reference source.
 - d. Your Paper must not be published in Academia.edu or any other journal, nor should it be currently under consideration for publication elsewhere.
 - e. Self-citation is not allowed unless that citation is in an ELE journal.
 - f. You must place two citations from our ELE journals in your paper's index.
- 7. Your paper will be reviewed by two reviewers and any problems will be referred back to you for attention.
- 8. As such we can NOT promise and do not promise any specific publishing date although we will do our best to publish it within 5 months of receipt of the final accepted version in the appropriate journal.
- 9. It is very important to understand that SCOPUS is a third-party company with its own rules and regulations. We cannot promise or guarantee that your paper will be indexed by SCOPUS. Only SCOPUS can do that.
- 10. Full paper submissions must be received by **December 31, 2019**. Papers will be published starting on the first half of 2020. A particular month for publication cannot be granted until our double blind review is complete and any changes necessary have been made.

Cancellation Policy

Early this year (2019), we had to cancel one event due to an earthquake destroying a partner's institutional conference facilities shortly before the event began. To eliminate any misunderstandings in the rare event of cancellations, the following applies:

- Cancellations made by the applicant fourteen (14) days before the event will be charged 20% of the full rate being administrative fees incurred. Applications for refund must be in writing.
- Cancellations made by the applicant seven (7) days before or no-show during the event will forfeit any conference fee paid to the Organizer/Institution.
- In case the registered presenters become unavailable to attend the conference, substitutions may be allowed, provided that the request for substitution is done in writing at least three (3) days prior the event. Please note that we cannot guarantee name changes in IDs, Certificates, and Conference books if the notice came too late.
- The Conference has two organizers TESOL Asia and the hosting institution :
 - 1. Conference fees are distributed between the two groups.
 - 2. In the event of a cancellation due to an Act of Nature (weather, earthquake, tsunami, or other natural occurrences) prior to or during an event, refunds are made on the following basis:
 - a. if the conference has officially opened, no refund will take place
 - b. if the incident occurs prior to the opening of the conference causing the cancellation, refund* requests must be made to (a) TESOL Asia and (b) the host intuition
 - 3. It is a condition of this clause that both the institution hosting the conference and TESOL Asia (Publisher) will have incurred costs prior to the event. As such full refunds cannot be made but a % calculated at approximately 50% or greater depending on the circumstances of the cancellation will be made. This **excludes** airfares and accommodation expenses, as these are not payable to the Event Organizers.
- In the event that the conference is cancelled by TESOL Asia, being non Act of Nature related, the registrant can choose one of the following options:
 - 1. to transfer the fee to another similar conference of the Organizer
 - 2. full refund

In the event that the conference is cancelled by the Host Institution, the registrant can seek full reimbursement from that institution.

^{*}Amount received by Organizers (net amount after charges) will be the basis of the amount to be refunded. Paypal and banks deduct a certain percentage as processing fee, thus Organizers do not receive the payment in full.



Re-scheduling / Postponement

In case the conference is re-scheduled / postponed due to unforeseen circumstances, same terms indicated above will apply.

Change of Venue

The conference venue is always known to the applicant prior to applying for the conference. That venue may be a university, college, school or other campus or hotel. TESOL Asia reserves the right to move the conference to alternative facilities in the same city for reasons of security, delegate convenience, or any other reason that may affect the Conference program. All registered applicants will be informed by **email**. There is no further cost to the applicant in this event.

Insuring Your Trip

By coming to a conference you may be purchasing flight tickets, hotel accommodation or car/bus transportation. In the event of a conference cancellation, these expenses are your sole legal responsibility and it is highly recommended to take out a Travel insurance policy that covers any cancellation or rescheduling.


